



Console Applications in VS 2017


1. Choose menu option File and then New Project




2. Under Visual C++, choose General and Empty Project, then click OK




3. In the Solution Explorer window, right click Source Files, then Add, then New Item.



4. Chose C++ File (.cpp) and click Add



5. Type in your C++ program, then click CTL-F (or Shift-F5) depending on your computer to compile and run. See the system("PAUSE"); in the code below. This keeps the output window open so that you can see your output.



6. Use File/Save or CTL-S to save your .cpp file.
